Summer School Policies

- All students **must** attend the first day of summer school at **8:30 AM** (regardless of session preference) to receive their username and password for Plato, as well as other important information.
 - *AM/PM session assignment will be given out at this time.*
- Exceptions to first day attendance *may* be made due to another obligation **only if it is communicated to an administrator at the high school prior to summer school beginning.**
- Students are allowed to work on summer school classes at home as long as they have the proper technology; however, **all pre-tests, post-tests, and final exams must be taken at the high school during Summer School hours.**
- Students must complete all coursework by the end of the Summer School term (July 30th). Extensions will not be granted.

Students who come to the high school to work on their summer school courses during designated summer school hours are typically more successful in completing their courses and earning their credits.
