Knightstown High School is located in Knightstown, Indiana of Henry County, 10 miles east of Greenfield, Indiana and approximately 30 miles from Indianapolis, Indiana. It is primarily a rural area with a few businesses with a population of less than 3,000. Many of our student's parents work outside of the area and travel between 20-60 miles to work.

Dual credit options include and Advanced Chemistry and Physics. KHS also has Career and Technical opportunities for students through the New Castle Area Career Programs.
