Knightstown High School is located in Knightstown, Indiana of Henry County, 10 miles east of Greenfield, Indiana and approximately 30 miles from Indianapolis, Indiana. It is primarily a rural area with a few businesses with a population of less than 3,000. Many of our students' parents work outside of the area and travel between 20-60 miles to work.

School System and Demographics

Charles A. Beard School Corporation enrolls approximately 1,300 students grades K-12. The three schools; Knightstown Elementary (K-3), Knightstown Intermediate School (4-8), and Knightstown High School (9-12) offer a wide variety of academic, athletic, co-curricular, and extra-curricular activities in an attempt to meet the varied interest and abilities of our student body. KHS offers the following Honors courses: Honors English 10, Honors English 11, Algebra II Honors, and Honors Pre-Calculus. Freshman students have the opportunity to earn an Honors English 9 credit by completing an honors project. KHS offers the following advanced placement courses: AP Calculus, AP Literature, AP Chemistry, AP Physics, AP 2D Art. Dual credit options include ACP Biology, ACP American History, AP Chemistry, AP Physics, ACP Composition, and ACP Speech. KHS also has many cooperative educational opportunities for students through the New Castle Area Career Programs.
