## E-Learning Days

One positive from the pandemic has been the emerging ability for students and teachers to work remotely from home. While nothing replaces having teachers working with students in person, this has been a good option to avoid having long periods of time where students receive no instruction at all.

As students navigate through their school work from home on E-Learning Days, here are some details you should know:

- Teachers will upload assignments to Google Classroom by 9:00 AM the morning of an E-Learning Day.
- Students should actively check for work and complete this work the day it's assigned.
- **An E-Learning Day is not a day off from school. Students need to do their work.**
- Teachers will monitor Google Classroom throughout the day and are available to answer questions.
- Students have 3 school days after the E-Learning day to make up assignments.
- We do not have to make up E-Learning Days; they count as school days.
