

ECLIPSE COMING TO KHS



The impending eclipse!

On April 8, 2024, a total solar eclipse will cross North America, passing Mexico, the United States, and Canada. The eclipse will begin over the South Pacific Ocean and continue through various states, including Mexico, the United States, and Canada. It will exit on the Atlantic coast of Newfoundland, Canada.

A solar eclipse occurs when the Moon passes between Earth and the Sun, blocking the view of the Sun from a small part of the Earth, totally or partially. For us, it will be a total solar eclipse.

We are lucky enough that Knightstown happens to fall in the line of totality, meaning we'll be able to experience the eclipse firsthand from our very own hometown. This is pretty much a once in a lifetime thing and many people will be coming to Knightstown during the day of the eclipse just to witness it. The longest duration for a total solar eclipse possible is 7.5 minutes. During this eclipse the shadow of the Moon races across the Earth at 2410 mph. Partial solar eclipses can be seen up to 3,000 miles from the "track" of totality. The maximum number of solar eclipses, whether they are annual, total, or partial, is 5 per year, and there are at least 2 solar eclipses per year somewhere on the Earth. Everyone in the continental U.S. will see at least a partial eclipse in their lifetime. Total eclipses occur on average, every 18 months. However, from the same place on Earth, you can only see one about every 300 to 400 years. This is admittedly one of the coolest things to happen to this town!
