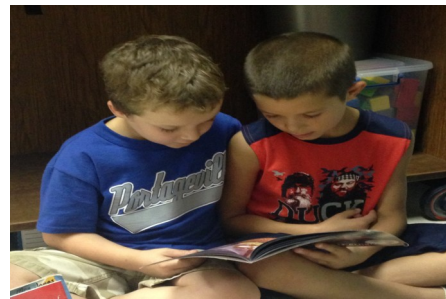

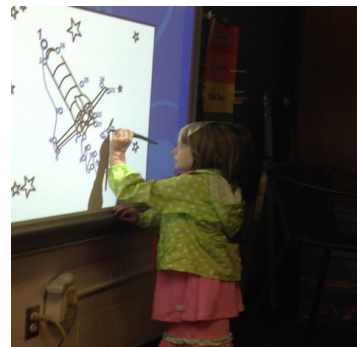
## CLASSROOM CORNER
